OUTSTANDING EDUCATOR AWARDS

The Bucks County Outstanding Educator Award is a recognition program for educators and directors working in Early Childhood Programs. Through a formalized nomination process, these individuals are recognized for their *outstanding* contribution to the field. Five Early Childhood Professionals will be honored by the Bucks County Chapter of PennAEYC.

How it works

Educators are nominated by peers, parents, directors, or consultants by filling out the form on the next page. Using *100 words or less*, highlight specific and special contributions of the nominee. Indicate what special talents, skills, commitment, service this person has shown to dedicate them to the field in a way that is above and beyond the call of duty, especially during this challenging year.

Nominations will be accepted until August 15th and winners will receive their award by a surprise presentation at their place of work this fall. An independent panel of judges appointed by the board will select the winners.
